SUBJECT: Savannah River Nuclear Solutions, LLC (SRNS), Contract DE-AC09-08SR22470, Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 Award Fee Determination

The Department of Energy’s National Nuclear Security Administration (DOE/NNSA) has completed its assessment of SRNS’s performance of the contract requirements for the period of October 1, 2022, through September 30, 2023, as evaluated against the Goals defined in the NNSA Corporate Performance Evaluation and Measurement Plan (PEMP).
